### **Tree Sales**

The Project is designed to provide low cost seedling trees and shrubs for windbreaks to prevent wind and soil erosion, protect buildings and livestock and reduce energy costs.



The Lower Wind River Conservation District is one of 34 in Wyoming and three in Fremont County. The District was formed on June 16, 1969 when the Pavillion and Wind River Conservation Districts were merged. Our district encompasses nearly two million acres including the communities of Pavillion, Kinnear, Riverton, Shoshoni, Moneta, Lysite and Lost Cabin. The Midvale Irrigation District (a United States Bureau of Reclamation project) as well as the two privately owned irrigation districts (LeClair and Riverton Valley) operate within this conservation district.

We are the local voice for natural resource conservation matters. We work closely with the Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS), a federal agency. This group provides technical assistance to us and people in our district.
